GCSE Photography trip to York 12/10/2023

The Photography department are organising a trip to York for our Year 11 students. All students currently studying Photography will be expected to attend to produce a body of work which will contribute significantly towards their final GCSE Photography exam. It will take place on Thursday 12th October 2023 and the cost is £10, which includes the train travel to York.

Students will need to be at Doncaster railway station for 8:15am on the 12th of October and will be returning at 14:24pm. We ask that students are either met at the station by parents or arrange alternative travel arrangements home.

During the day, students will be visiting the Railway Museum and areas within the city of York. Although they are not required to wear Academy uniform, please ensure that they wear sensible walking shoes. They must bring a fully charged camera or phone with enough space to take at least 300 photographs.

Students may wish to bring money to buy lunch, or they may want to bring a packed lunch. Packed lunches will be provided for those students on free school meals.
