At the end of Y9 students will complete a test for 60 minutes that will reflect the substantive knowledge and disciplinary skills from this academic year. It will mirror the GCSE format and include a range of questions from 1 mark multiple choice to 9 mark figure based exam responses, totalling 60 marks. It will allow gaps to be closed prior to moving onto KS4.
