Students are expected to wear full academy uniform on the day. The venue will provide lunch for all students, however they may wish to bring extra food and drinks as the timings extend beyond the academy day. If the student is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided.

Students will be supervised by members of academy staff during the visit and there will be a trained first aider present as part of this supervision.
