Visit to Birmingham Utilita Arena to watch International Badminton

We are delighted to confirm that your child has been allocated a place on the visit to the Birmingham Utilita Arena to watch International Badminton. By attending this visit, students will access an exceptional learning experience. The cost of this visit is £20.00, which covers the costs for tickets and coach transport.

Students are required to meet in the lower atrium at 08:55 am and will leave the academy at 9:00 am, returning to the academy, at 5:00/5:30 pm dependent on traffic. As the return time is after the end of the academy day, information regarding student dismissal will be taken from the consent form sent out earlier in the year.

Payment should be made via the ParentPay facility. If you are unable to access to ParentPay and require a barcoded letter to pay at a PayPoint, please email admin@stwacademy.com and a letter will be printed for the student to collect from Reception. The deadline for payment is Monday 27 January 2025. If you are facing financial hardship and are unable to make the payment, please contact admin@stwacademy.com and a member of staff will contact you to discuss options in which we may be able to offer support.

Please note that if there are insufficient students to make this visit viable, then it will be cancelled and a full refund will be issued.

Please also note that giving consent and making payment, does not automatically guarantee the student's participation in the visit. This is dependent on student behaviour, attendance and motivation.

Due to the nature of the day students will not need to be in full school uniform. However, clothing and footwear worn should be comfortable, and appropriate for the visit. Students will require a packed lunch for the day and/or money to purchase further food should they wish to do so. If the student is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided.

Students will be supervised by members of academy staff during the visit and there will be a trained first aider present as part of this supervision. If there are occasions on this visit where students are casually supervised, students will be briefed ahead of the visit with the meeting points, times and details on how to contact a member of academy staff in the event of an emergency.
