Yorkshire Vikings vs Lancashire Lightning

We are delighted to confirm that your child has been allocated a place on the visit to the Yorkshire County Cricket Club at Headingley Stadium on Thursday 17 July 2025. This visit will allow your child to watch live first-class and professional cricket, with the potential to meet players. By attending this visit, students will access an exceptional learning experience. The cost of this visit is £25.00, which covers the fee for both the ticket and transport to and from the venue.

Students are required to meet at the academy at 4:00 pm and will leave the academy at 4:15 pm returning to the academy, at 10:30 pm. As the return time is after the end of the academy day, parent/carers must make arrangements to collect the student from the academy.

Payment should be made via the ParentPay facility. If you are unable to access ParentPay and require a barcoded letter to pay at a PayPoint, please email admin@stwacademy.com and a letter will be printed for the student to collect from Reception. The deadline for payment is Thursday 3 July 2025. If you are facing financial hardship and are unable to make the payment, please contact admin@stwacademy.com and a member of staff will contact you to discuss options in which we may be able to offer support.

Please note that if there are insufficient students to make this visit viable, then it will be cancelled and a full refund will be issued.

Please also note that giving consent and making payment, does not automatically guarantee the student's participation in the visit. This is dependent on student behaviour, attendance and motivation.

Due to the nature of the day, students will not need to be in full school uniform, except for their lanyard. However, clothing and footwear worn should be smart, comfortable, and appropriate for the visit. Students will require a packed lunch for the day and money to purchase further food should they wish to do so; although this opportunity cannot be guaranteed. If the student is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided.

Students will be supervised by members of academy staff during the visit and there will be a trained first aider present as part of this supervision. If there are occasions on this visit where students are passively supervised, students will be briefed ahead of the visit with the meeting points, times and details on how to contact a member of academy staff in the event of an emergency.
